The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG), as the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Counties of Imperial, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Ventura, is pleased to transmit the Fiscal Year 2020/21 – 2025/26 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (2021 FTIP).
