Honorable SCAG President Hagman, Transportation Committee Chair Sandoval, and Regional Council Members:

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) strongly supports SCAG staff recommendations to approve the 2023-2026 CRP-CMAQ-STBG Project Award List and Contingency List and to authorize the SCAG Executive Director or his designee to make programming adjustments as necessary.

RCTC's process for facilitating nominations under SCAG's call for projects was approved by our Commission in December 2023, and included frequent ongoing stakeholder outreach and collaboration to ensure all eligible applicants had an opportunity to consider pursuing funding from the SCAG call for projects. As a result, Riverside County jurisdictions submitted 13 applications totaling \$108.9 million. RCTC is pleased that Riverside County is recommended to receive a regionally appropriate portion of the federal formula funds available for a multimodal mix of projects that will advance mobility and accelerate clean transportation options in our county.

RCTC thanks SCAG staff for their constant collaboration with the county transportation commissions on this inaugural cycle for competitive distribution of federal formula funding. We look forward to continuing to collaborate with your staff as future cycles of this call for projects arise.
