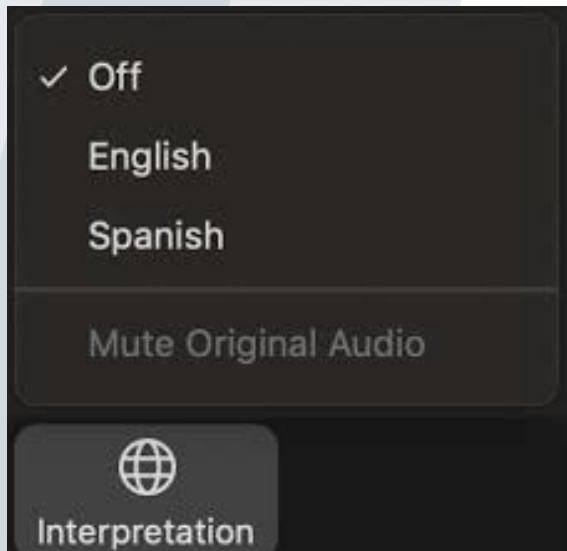

Goals

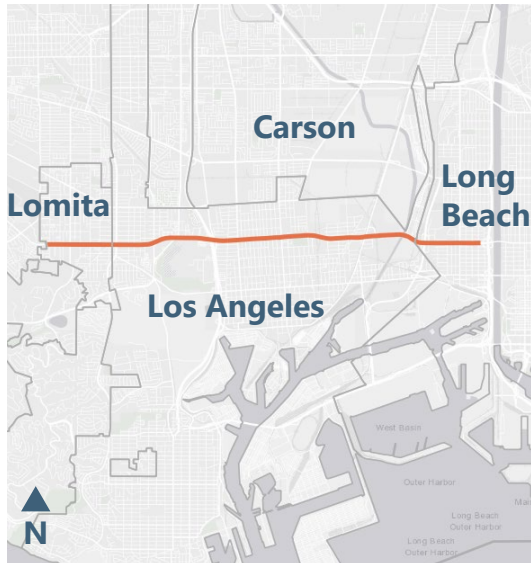
- Improve safety and accessibility for all modes of transportation.

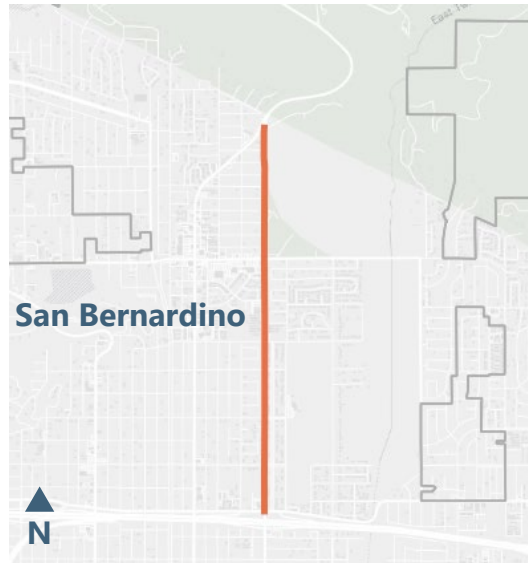
Scope

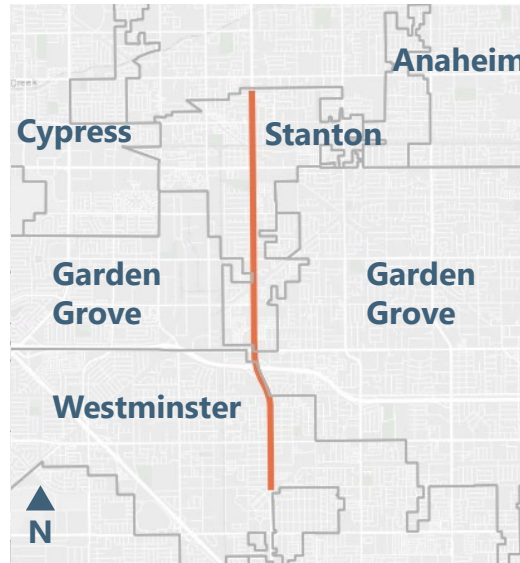

Project Timeline



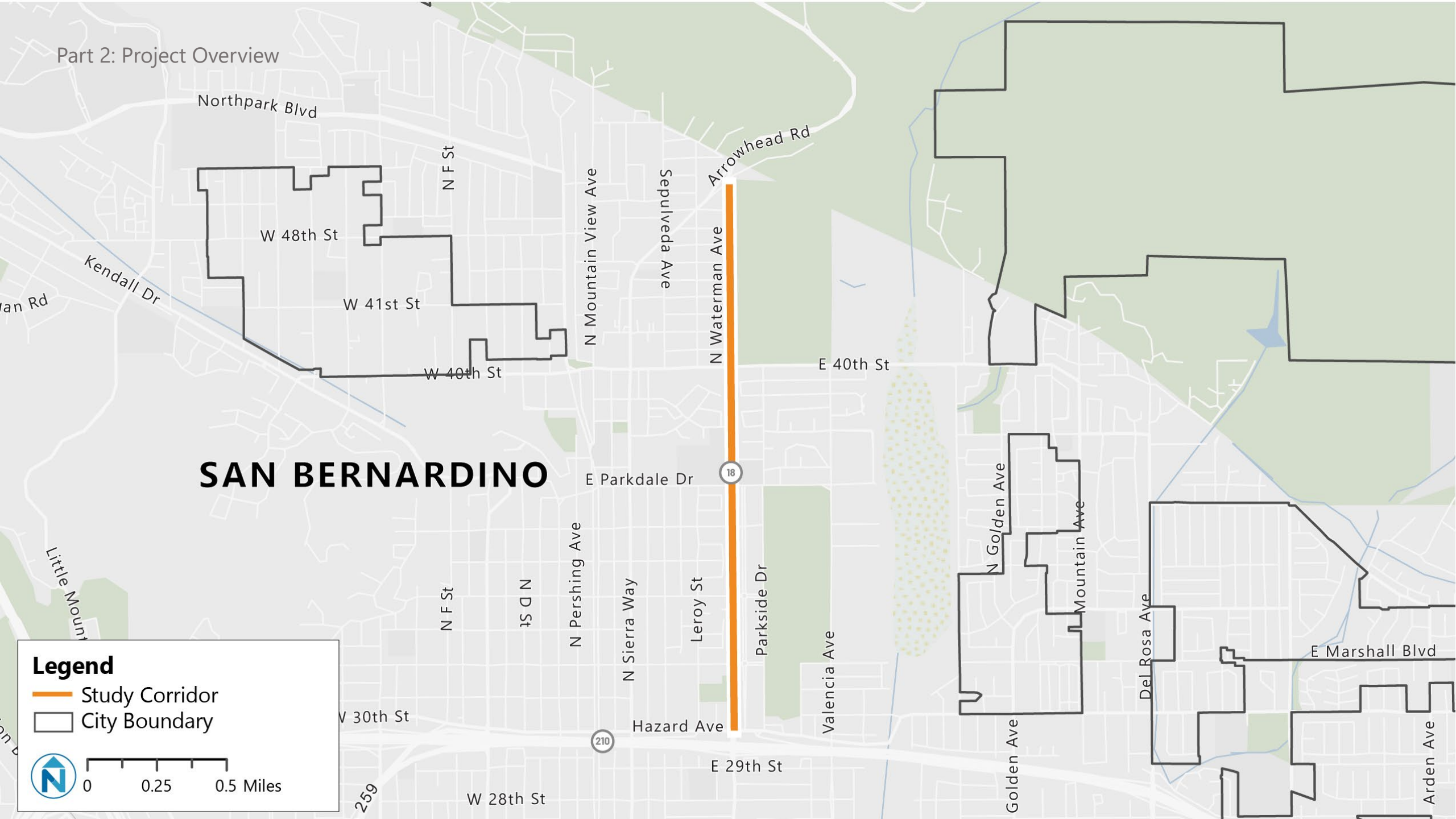

Extents	~2 miles from Arrowhead Road to 30 th Street
Partner Agencies	• City of San Bernardino • Caltrans D8 • SBCTA
Transportation Overview	• Gateway to Lake Arrowhead and San Bernardino National Forest • Used by residents everyday to travel between to and from homes, schools at Parkdale Drive, businesses along 40th Street, and SR 210

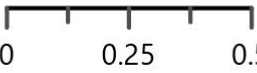

Community Survey Snapshot

SR-18 in San Bernardino

Survey Overview

- **186 responses** (all in English) collected (Dec 2025 – Jan 2026)

Key Travel Patterns

- Driving is the primary mode (84%)
- Limited walking (7%) and biking (4%)

Key Concerns

- 83% say the street environment is not comfortable
- 74% feel uncomfortable walking or biking

Top Requested Improvements

- New or improved sidewalks (18%)
- New lighting (16%)
- Slower vehicle speeds (13%)

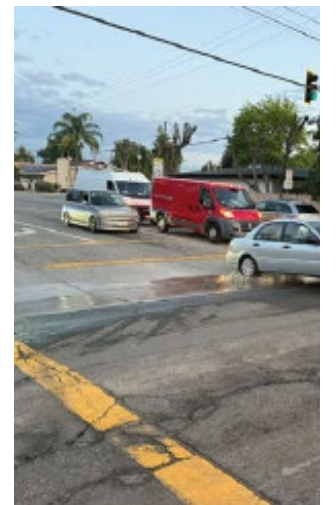
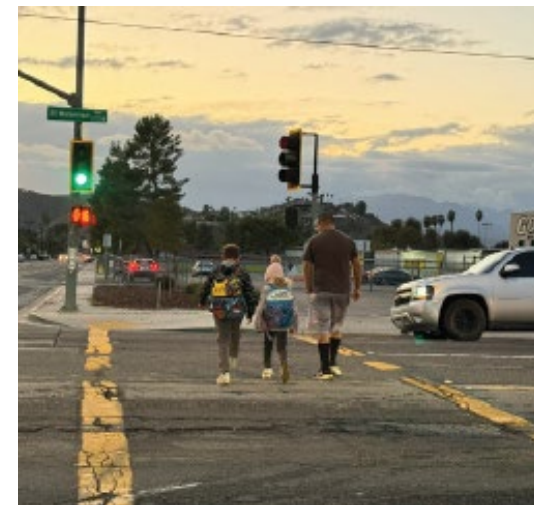
Overview

- Local residents, agency staff, and project team members



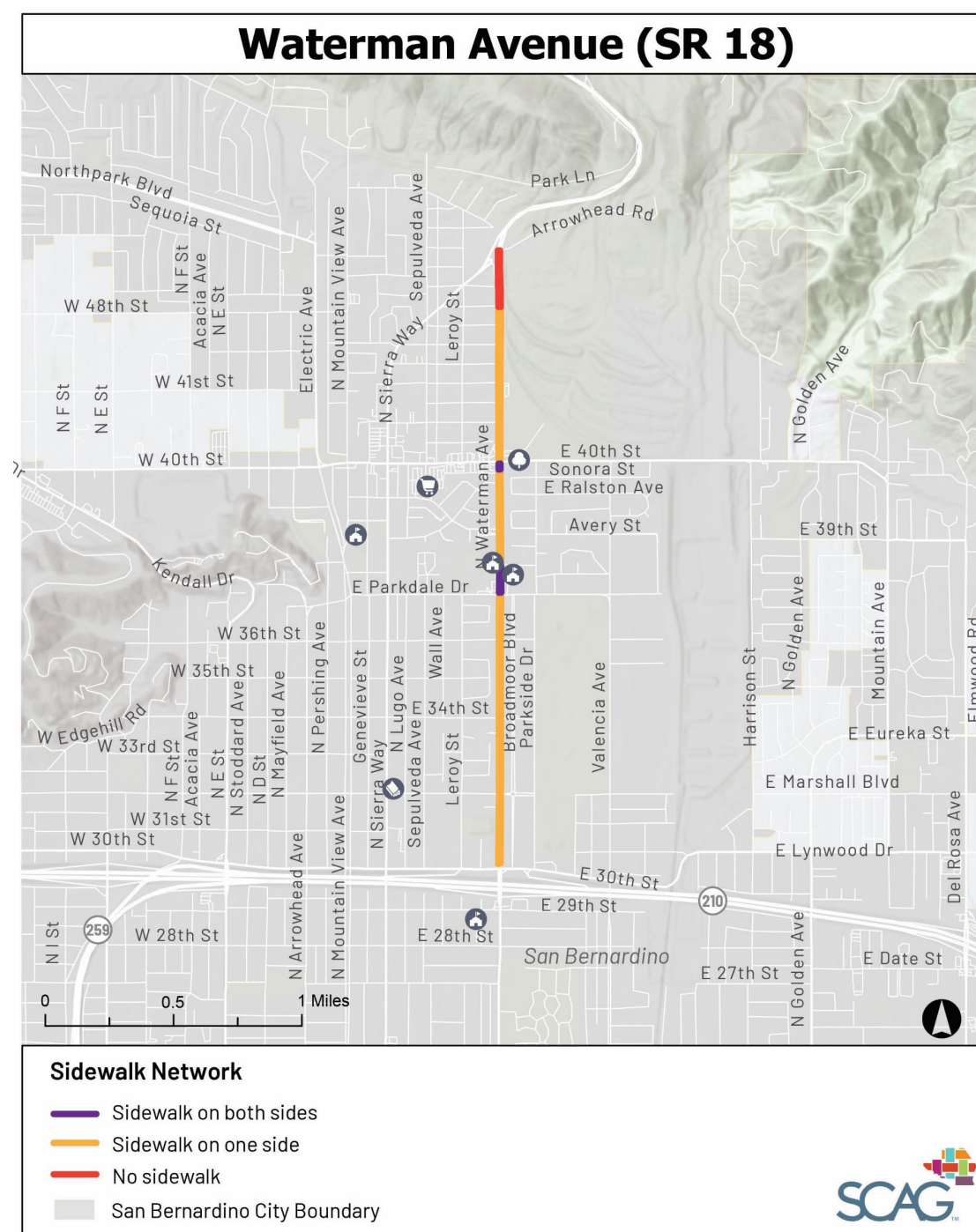
Key Issues Observed

- High vehicle speeds and traffic volumes
- Missing, obstructed, or discontinuous sidewalks
- Curb ramps missing or not aligned with crosswalks
- Poor pavement conditions and faded striping



Sidewalk Network

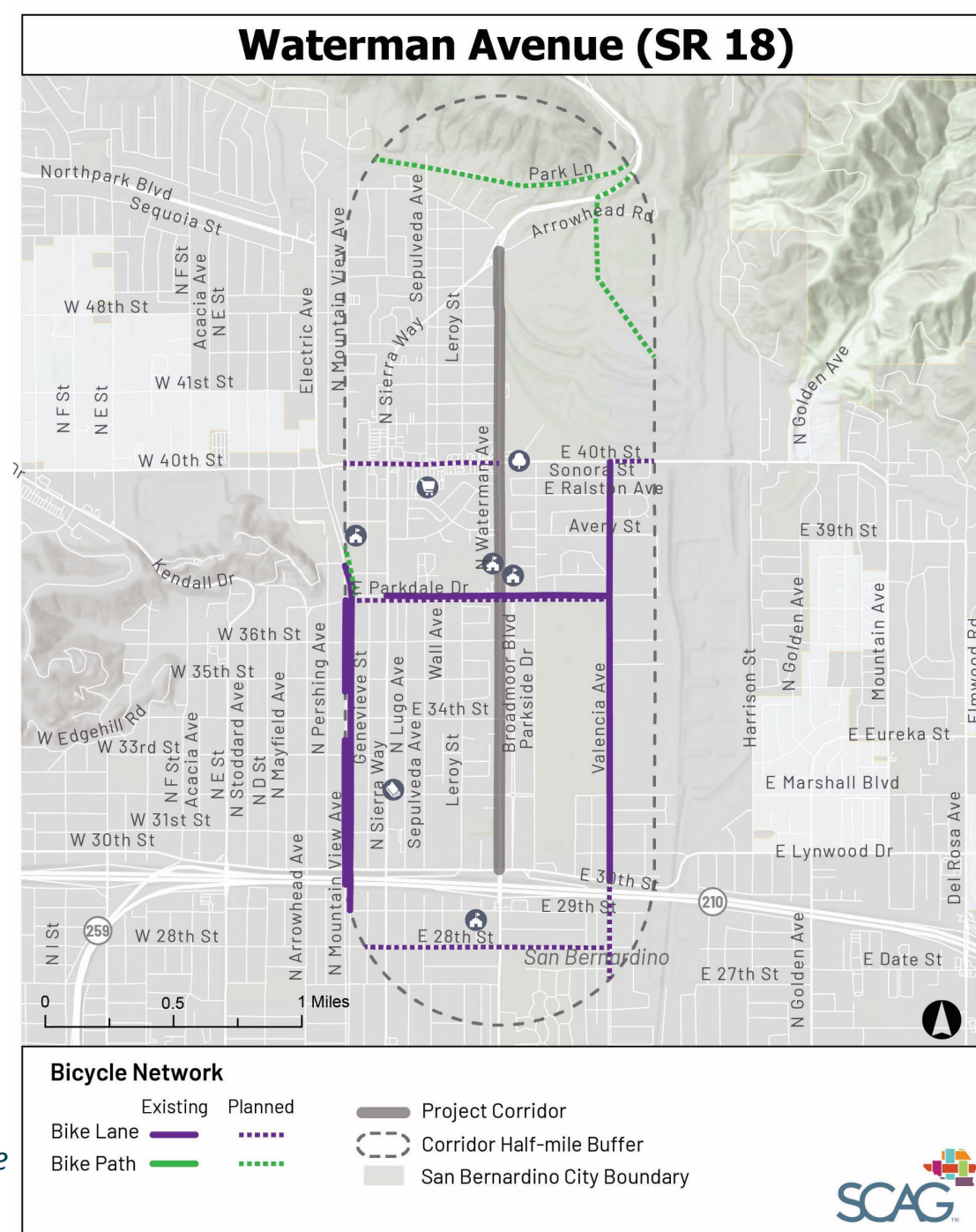
- Majority of the corridor has sidewalks on one side of the street
- No sidewalks from Arrowhead Road to 48th Street



Bicycle Network

- No bike facilities on the corridor
- Intersecting bike facilities along Parkdale Drive
- Parallel bike facilities:
 - Mountain View Avenue
 - Valencia Avenue
