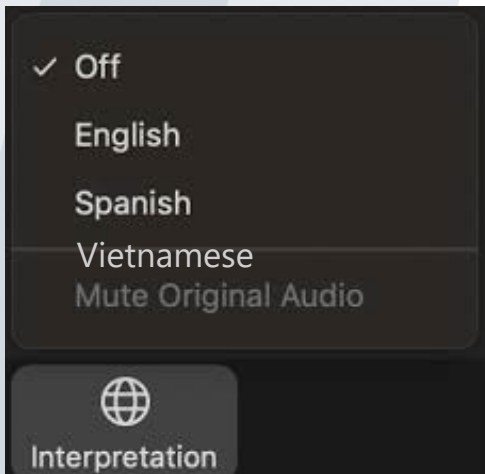

Goals

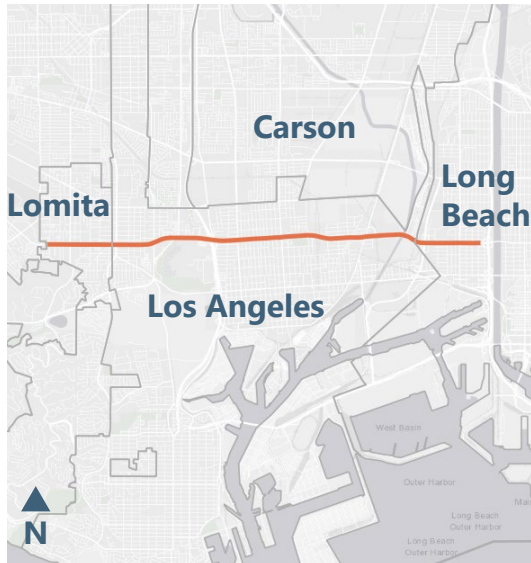
- Improve safety and accessibility for all modes of transportation.

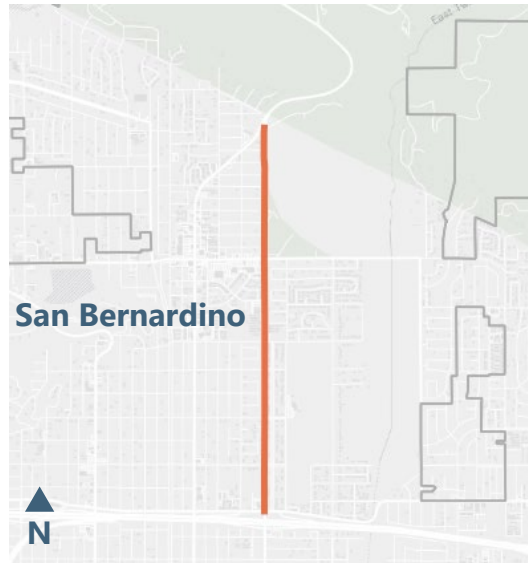
Scope

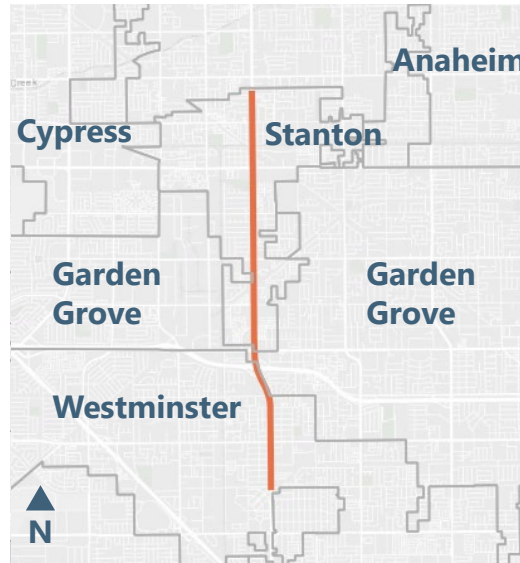

Project Timeline



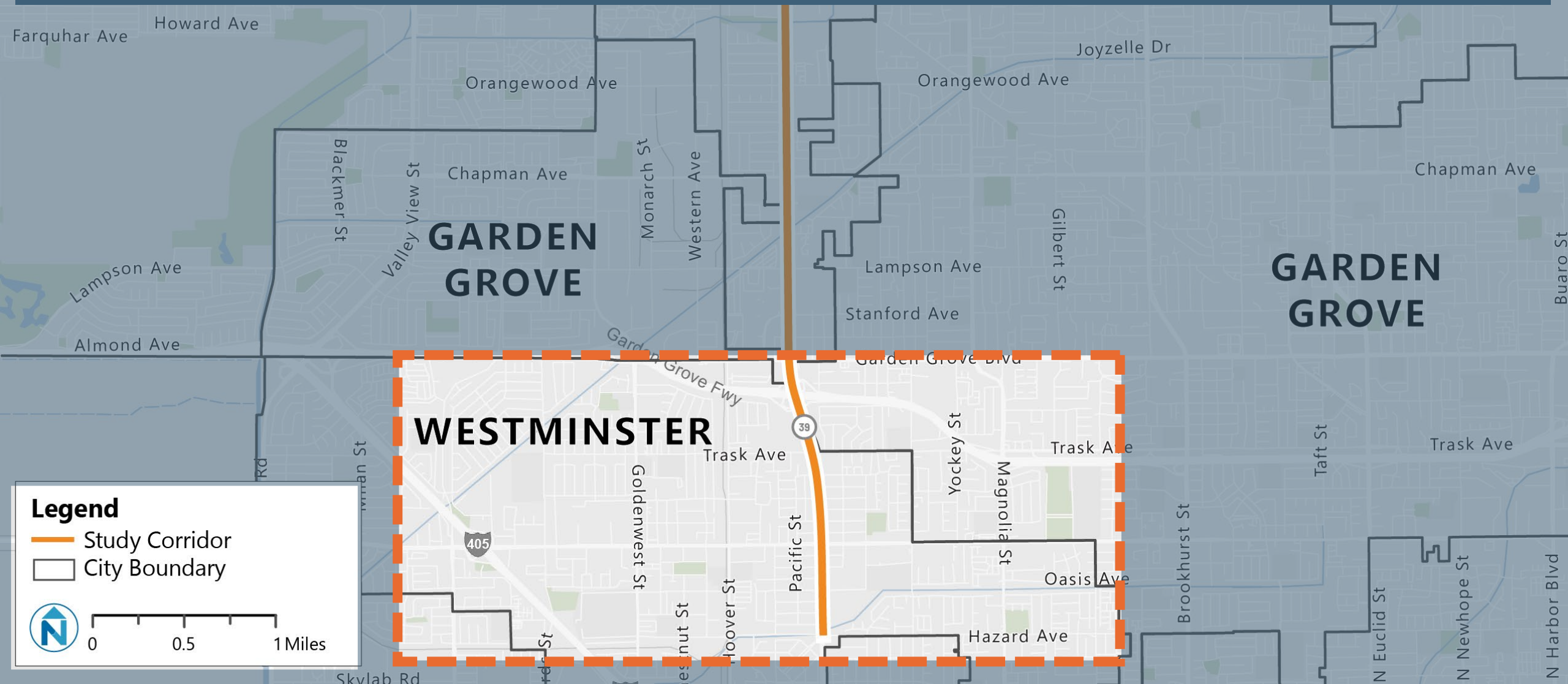

Study Corridor Overview

Extents	~4.5 miles from Starr Street to Hazard Avenue
Partner Agencies	• City of Stanton, • City of Westminster • Caltrans D12 • OCTA
Transportation Overview	• High vehicular traffic due to multiple strip malls, office parks, and intersection with SR 22 • Served by several OCTA bus routes

Community Survey Snapshot

SR-39 in Stanton and Westminster

Survey Overview

- **130 responses** (126 English, 4 in Spanish) collected (Dec 2025 – Jan 2026)

Key Travel Patterns

- Driving is the primary mode (73%), followed by walking (12%) and biking (7%)

Key Concerns

- 69% say the street environment is not comfortable
- 60% feel uncomfortable walking or biking

Top Requested Improvements

- New and/or improved lighting (36%)
- Better-maintained sidewalks (17%)
- New bicycle facilities (11%)

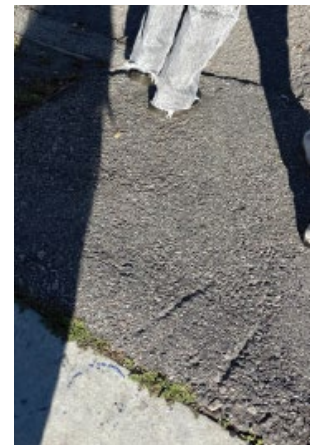
Overview

- 13 participants
- Local residents, City staff, agency staff, and project team members



Key Issues Observed

- High-speed traffic and frequent collisions
- Inconsistent or missing sidewalks
- Sidewalks obstructed by utility poles
- Limited lighting and shading along the corridor

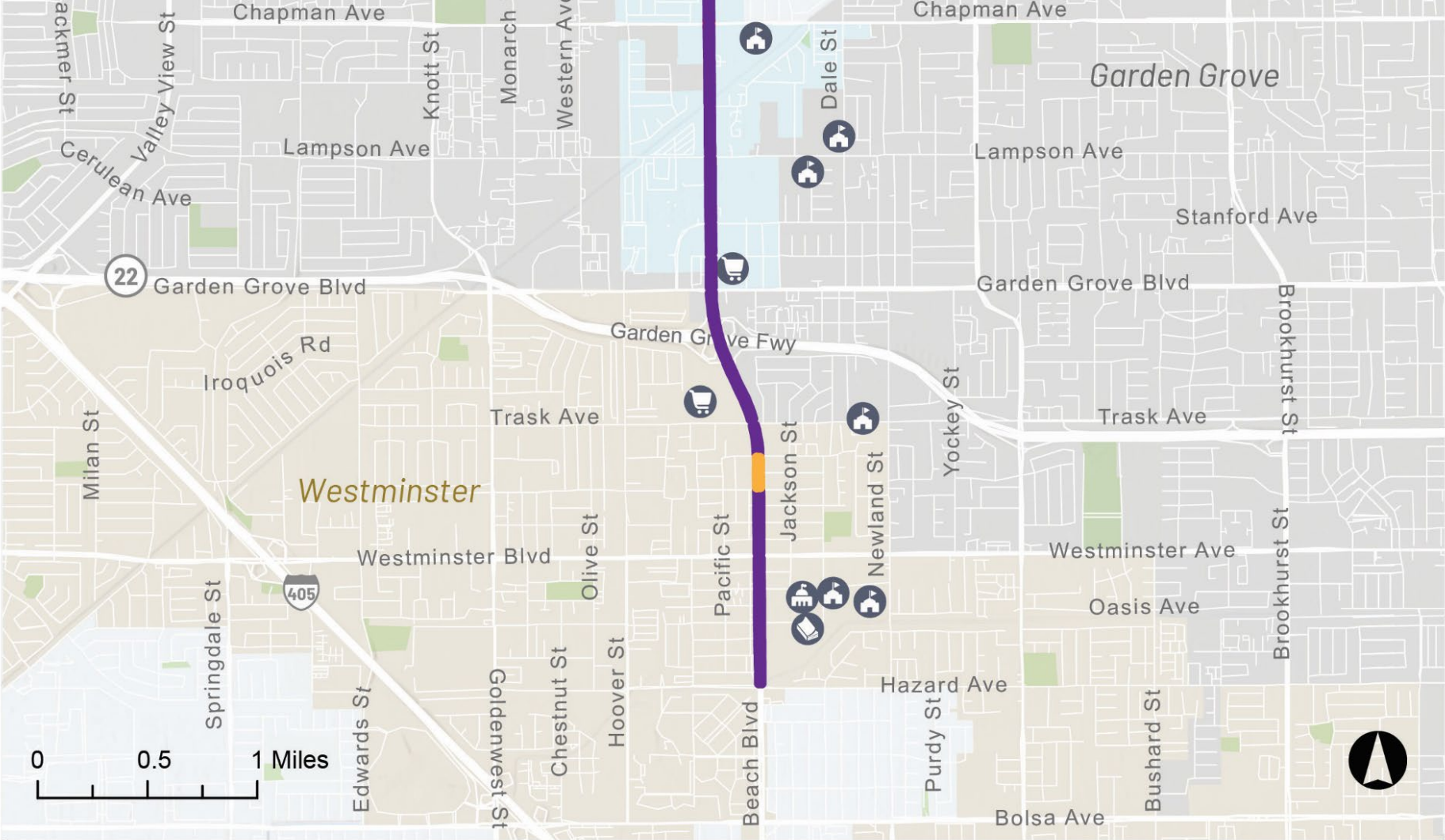

Sidewalk Network



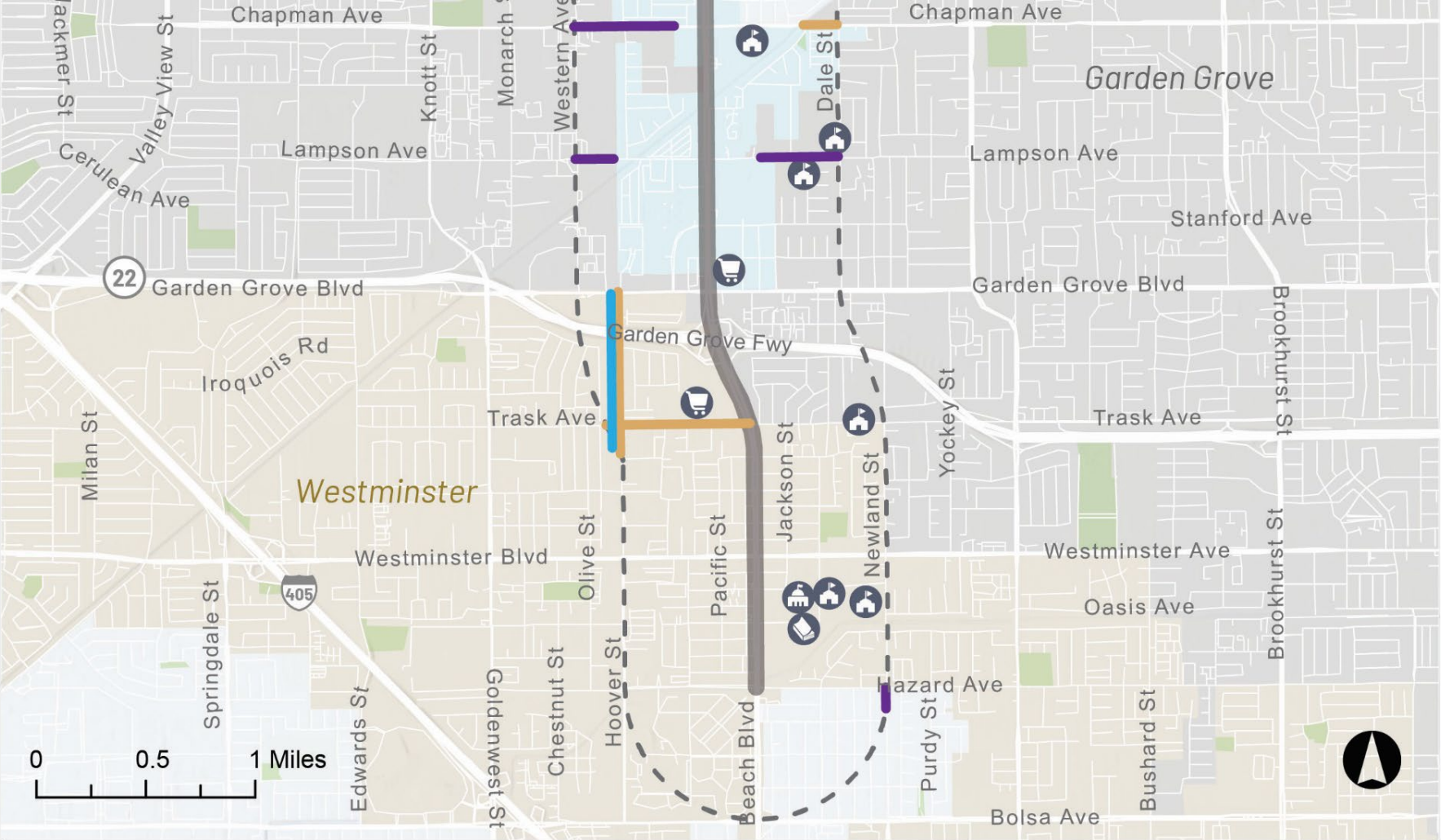

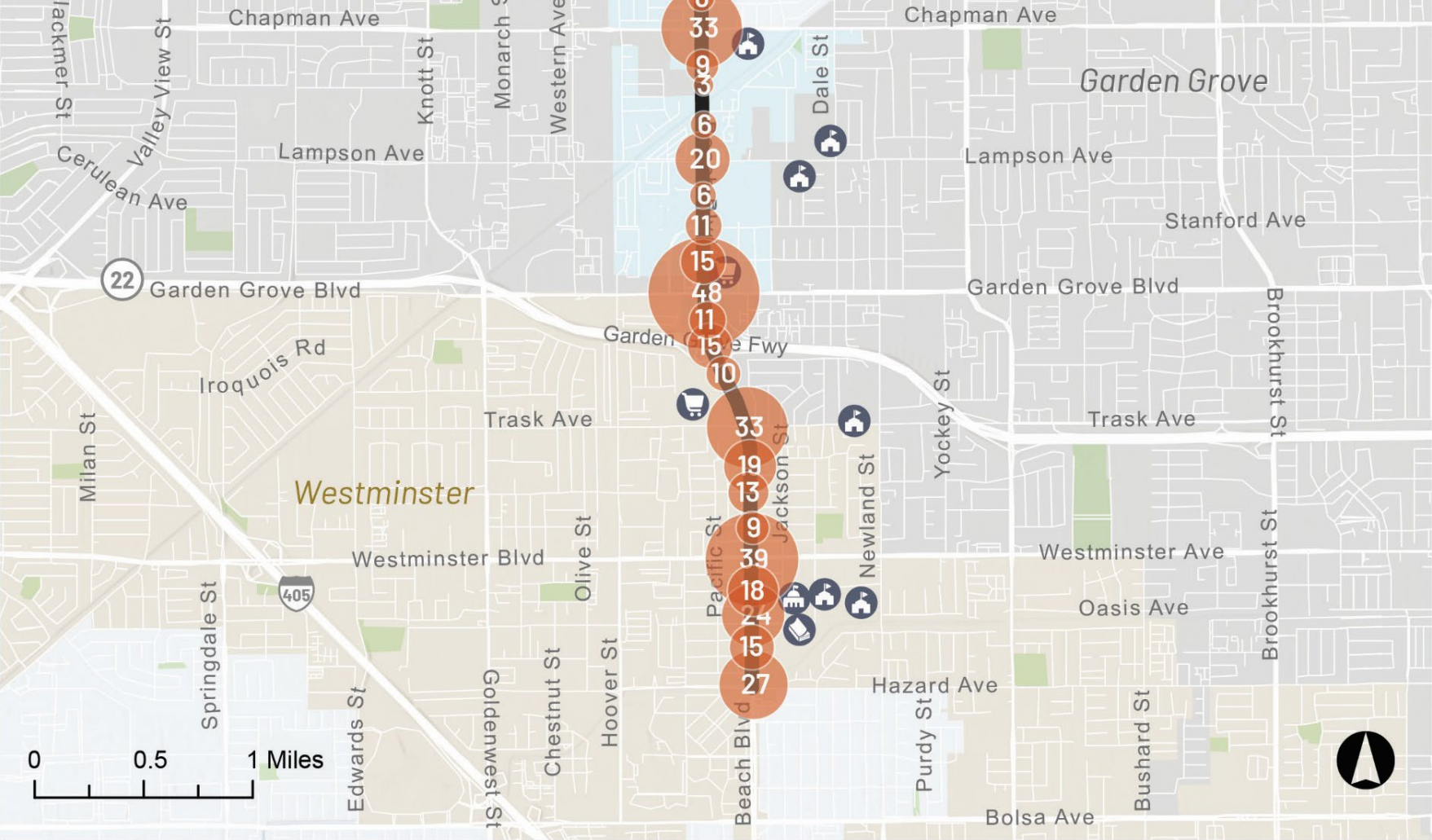

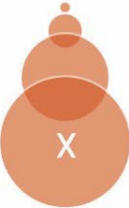
