Subject: Final RHNA question on Methodology

Dear SCAG:

I know that the "Riverside" RHNA algorithm has been submitted to HCD for review. I was at that November meeting where that algorithm was discussed, and various amendments, etc were also talked about.

These were the two algorithms (basically):

- 1) The SCAG algorithm had a **50/25/25** split between growth, HQTA, and Job Proximity.
- 2) The "Riverside" algorithm, which got approved at the last minute, had a **0/50/50** split.

I propose a simple compromise: 33/33/33 split between growth, HQTA and Job Proximity.
Probably neither side will like it as well as their preferred algorithm, which means it is a good compromise!

Could you please pass this on to HCD? (Or comment on it yourself?)
