## **NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY** & NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The draft 2025 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) and draft Amendment 1 to the Connect SoCal 2024 (Regional Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy [RTP/SCS or "Connect SoCal 2024"]) are available for public review and comment. Information on how to provide public comment is contained in this notice.

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) has prepared the draft 2025 FTIP in compliance with the adopted Connect SoCal 2024 and all federal and state requirements. SCAG has also prepared the draft Amendment 1 to the Connect SoCal 2024 to reflect additions, deletions, and/or changes to several critical transportation projects that are ready to move forward to the implementation phase.

A major component of Connect SoCal 2024 is a Project List that contains thousands of individual transportation projects throughout the SCAG region. Since Connect SoCal 2024's adoption, some of these transportation projects have experienced technical changes that are time sensitive. In addition, the county transportation commissions in the SCAG region have identified new priority transportation projects, as well as projects that are no longer identified as priorities. The 2025 FTIP and Amendment 1 to the Connect SoCal 2024 are needed to allow these projects to proceed in a timely manner. The 30-day public review and comment period for the draft 2025 FTIP and draft Connect SoCal 2024 Amendment 1 begins on July 12, 2024, and ends on August 12, 2024, at 5 p.m.
