

Affordable ConnectivityProgram

The federally-funded Affordable Connectivity Program helps connect families and household struggling to afford internet service. This provides eligible households up to \$30/month discount for internet service.

Eligible households qualify to receive discounts on their internet plan:

- ➤ Up to \$30/month
- ➤ Up to \$75/month (Tribal Lands)
- ➤ A one time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider

You may be eligible for ACP benefits if someone in your household is enrolled in any of the following programs:

- ✓ SNAP, Medicaid/Medical, Lifeline
- ✓ Federal Pell Grant
- ✓ Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits
- ✓ Federal Public Housing Assistance
- ✓ Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- ✓ WIC, Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program
- ✓ Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
- ✓ Tribal TANF, Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations, or Tribal Head Start (income based)
- ✓ Or household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

TWO STEPS TO ENROLL

Go to **GetInternet.Gov** to submit an application or print a mail-in application

2

Contact your preferred participating provider to select an eligible plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Some providers may have an alternative application that they will ask you to complete.

Eligible households must <u>both</u> apply for the program <u>and</u> contact a participating provider to select a service plan.
