6. AB 1637 (Irwin): Local Government: Internet Websites and Email Addresses

There were no public comments for Item No. 6.

Mr. Francisco Barajas, Legislative Analyst, presented on AB 1637 (Irwin), as requested by committee members at the July 2023 LCMC meeting. Mr. Barajas informed the committee that in its current iteration, the bill would require all California cities and counties to migrate to a “.gov” or “.ca.gov” domain name for their websites, redirect noncompliant websites to domain name that utilizes a “.gov” or “.ca.gov” page, or ensure each email address provided to employees utilizes a “.gov” or “.ca.gov” domain name. Mr. Barajas explained that the bill was amended to push out the implementation timeline to five years to give cities and counties until January 2029 to comply. Mr. Barajas noted that the most pertinent benefit of the use of the suggested domains is to provide the public the assurance that the website being accessed is a governmental website. Mr. Barajas further explained that Senate and Assembly appropriations have both pointed out that these costs are likely reimbursable by the State, however, that will not be guaranteed until a determination is made by the Commission on State Mandates.

Chair Lock Dawson opened the floor to the committee members for questions or comments.

Committee members engaged in a discussion on AB 1637 (Irwin). During the discussion, the committee provided comments and raised several questions related to the bill moving forward. Mr. Barajas addressed the committee’s comments and questions. The committee members motioned to adopt an oppose position.

A MOTION was made (Bucknum) to take an oppose position on AB 1637. The MOTION was SECONDED (Wapner) and APPROVED by a majority roll call vote as follows:

#### 7. LCMC 2023-2024 Schedule of Meetings

Ms. Cartagena shared with the committee that AB 1335 (Zbur) would be held as a two-year bill. She mentioned that conversations on this bill will likely continue later this fall.

Ms. Cartagena also provided the committee with information regarding upcoming events which include SCAG's 34<sup>th</sup> Demographic Workshop and Mobility 21 2023 Summit.

Lastly, Ms. Cartagena informed the committee that three new staff members would be joining the division in continuing efforts to revamp the Media and Public Affairs department. Chair Lock Dawson opened the floor to the committee members for questions or comments.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Item 1:** The Intelligent Transportation Society of America

**Type:** Membership      **Amount:** \$8,000

The Intelligent Transportation Society of America (ITS America), a non-profit established in 1991, advocates for deploying Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) in the United States. **STRATEGIC PLAN:**

This item supports the following Strategic Plan Goal 2: Advance Southern California’s policy interests and planning priorities through regional, statewide, and national engagement and advocacy.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

*The Legislative Tracking Report is provided to keep the Legislative/Communications and Membership Committee (LCMC) apprised of the bills in Sacramento that have a nexus to the Regional Council’s adopted Legislative Platform. The attached report includes 224 such legislative bills.*

**BACKGROUND:**

SCAG’s Legislative Tracking Report serves as a resource for the Committee to remain informed on bills moving through the legislative process in Sacramento. The Report tracks 224 measures with a nexus to the Regional Council’s adopted 2023 State and Federal Legislative Platform.

The Legislature’s Summer Recess began on July 14, 2023, but the legislative session reconvened on August 14, 2023. Since then, and for the past month, legislators worked to pass the last bills of 2023 as the Legislature entered its interim recess on September 14, 2023. The legislature is now on recess until January 3, 2024.

As the first half of the 2023-2024 Legislative Session has officially ended, Governor Newsom now has about one month to sign or veto bills passed by the legislature that reached his desk after September 14, with a deadline of October 14, 2023. For any bills that the legislature passed and reached the Governor’s desk *before* September 14, the Governor will have the usual 12 days to sign or veto.





This year, SCAG took a position on an astounding 34 bills! While many have died, are two-year bills, or have already been signed into law, some are still pending the Governor’s final action. SCAG’s official 2023 Bill Position Tracker is attached to this staff report, and staff will include an update on the final disposition of all the bills on which the agency took a position at the next LCMC in November. The table below highlights recent and upcoming legislative deadlines:

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

**STRATEGIC PLAN:**

This item supports the following Strategic Plan Goal 2: Advance Southern California’s policy interests and planning priorities through regional, statewide, and national engagement and advocacy.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

*At its September 7, 2023 meeting, the Regional Council (RC) approved recommendations on Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) reform and authorized the SCAG Executive Director to submit a comment letter on behalf of SCAG to the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD). The recommendations in that letter include proposals requiring legislative action, administrative recommendations under the purview of HCD, and methodological recommendations for SCAG’s consideration during the 7<sup>th</sup> Cycle RHNA.*

*For today’s Legislative/Communications and Membership Committee (LCMC) meeting, staff presents the six legislative concepts included in the comment letter for information and further discussion by Committee Members. The legislative concepts may serve as the basis for SCAG-sponsored legislation in the 2024 legislative year, following a future recommendation of the LCMC and a vote by the RC to adopt those recommendations.*

**BACKGROUND:**

At its September 7, 2023 meeting, the RC approved a series of recommendations on RHNA reform and authorized the Executive Director to submit a comment letter on behalf of SCAG to the HCD. The recommendations in that letter include six legislative concepts requiring legislative action.

The six recommendations for potential legislative changes to the RHNA program are listed as follows:

1. Extend existing need from the regional determination across multiple planning cycles to ensure that the RHNA can be fully accommodated by jurisdictions. Correspondingly, extend the housing element planning periods over multiple cycles to be consistent with the extension of the determination period for existing need.
2. Recommend that procedures be established for HCD to publicize its data sources, analyses, and methodology, including assumptions and factors used in the California Department of Finance (DOF) projections and engagement process with the Council of Governments (COG), prior to finalization of the regional determination to facilitate a transparent process with accessible information prior to finalization from HCD.
3. Establish formal processes to review and document HCD's considerations as part of its regional determination. HCD should also convene an advisory panel of experts that would advise HCD on their assumptions, data, and analysis prior to HCD making its final determination, which would also minimize politicization of the process.
4. Establish additional due process opportunities for housing need determination with defined grounds on which COGs and jurisdictions can appeal the methodology and assumptions used for housing need determination.
5. Codify an earlier date, which is currently at least 26 months before a housing element due date, for HCD to provide the regional determination to a COG so that more time is available to coordinate with the concurrent Sustainable Communities Strategy, prepare the RHNA methodology, increase local engagement, and have potentially additional time for the appeals process.
6. Reinstate a trade and transfer option of RHNA units between two jurisdictions with limitations so that it also furthers state housing objectives, including affirmatively furthering fair housing.

The legislative concepts could serve as the basis for SCAG-sponsored legislation in the 2024 legislative year, following a future recommendation of the LCMC and a vote by the RC. For today's LCMC meeting, however, staff presents the six legislative concepts for information and further discussion by Committee Members.

Additional background on the RHNA program, AB 101 and Sacramento's interest in RHNA reform, SCAG's RHNA reform stakeholder engagement process, and legislative next steps are included below.

---

**The RHNA Program:**

The RHNA Program is a process that determines the existing and projected housing needs for each jurisdiction within the State of California. This housing need, also known as the RHNA allocation, covers an eight-year period and requires each city and county to plan for this need in its housing element by analyzing suitable sites and implementing various programs, including rezoning.

HCD provides a regional RHNA determination to each COG in California, including SCAG. HCD determines the total housing need for the region, and the COG is responsible for developing a methodology to distribute this need to individual cities and counties. The most recent, 6<sup>th</sup> cycle RHNA determination for the SCAG region is 1,341,827 housing units across four income categories for the planning period spanning October 2021 through October 2029.

Government Code Section 65584.01 outlines the steps HCD must follow to calculate each region's RHNA determination. In addition to the population projections provided by the DOF and regional population forecasts that the COGs use to prepare their regional transportation plans, HCD also considers other factors in its assessments, such as anticipated household growth, over-crowding rates, and the relationship between jobs and housing, among other factors.

HCD is required to meet and consult with the COGs regarding assumptions and methodology. However, HCD is responsible for making the final assumptions for each required factor and providing a regional determination. A COG may object to HCD's determination, though HCD ultimately makes the final decision for a regional determination.

**AB 101 & Sacramento's Interest in RHNA Reform:**

In October 2021, the California State Joint Legislative Audit Committee approved an emergency audit to examine HCD's regional determination process. The request for an audit was based on the assertion that "the public has almost no information about the formula HCD uses to calculate these initial numbers." As part of its audit, the State Auditor examined three regions: Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG), Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), and Amador County.

Based on the California State Auditor's findings published in March 2022, HCD made several errors in making regional determinations for the regions reviewed, indicating that the regional determinations were understated for these three regions and possibly others as well. As a result of these errors and inaccuracies, the State Auditor made several recommendations to improve the RHNA process.

Separately, Assembly Bill (AB) 101 (2019), the budget trailer bill for housing-related programs for that year, requires HCD, in collaboration with the Governor's Office of Planning and Research, to conduct a RHNA reform effort and make recommendations to the legislature to revamp the existing

RHNA program. Subsequent legislation amended the due date for these efforts to December 31, 2023.

To ensure that comments from stakeholders in the SCAG region are considered as part of HCD's AB 101 RHNA reform, SCAG conducted its own concurrent engagement process to inform RHNA reform recommendations to HCD.

### **SCAG RHNA Reform Process**

In the Summer of 2022, SCAG staff conducted an initial stakeholder engagement process to gather input and feedback on RHNA reform. The initial outreach process included a publicized comment period, one public listening session, five presentations to sub-regional COGs in the SCAG region, and a presentation each to the Housing Working Group and Technical Working Group. Staff reviewed the feedback and comments submitted during this process and prepared draft recommendations made available for public comment in May 2023.

Between May and June 2023, SCAG held a second public engagement process on the draft recommendations. SCAG held two public listening sessions on June 22, 2023, and June 27, 2023, to gather feedback on the draft recommendations. In addition, SCAG staff posted a RHNA reform survey on the SCAG website and solicited written comment letters. The input was used to refine and augment the draft recommendations as appropriate.

SCAG staff provided RHNA reform outreach process updates to the Community, Economic and Human Development (CEHD) Committee at its June 1, 2023, and July 6, 2023, meetings. A special meeting of the CEHD was held on August 16, 2023, at which the CEHD recommended that the RC approve a matrix of opportunities to improve the RHNA program. The RC approved that recommendation and a draft comment letter at its September 7, 2023 meeting.

### **Next Steps:**

Following today's discussion by the LCMC on the six legislative concepts, staff will conduct further analysis and return to a future meeting of the LCMC with a recommendation on how to proceed. Any recommendation from the LCMC would flow to the following RC meeting for final approval.

Once legislative concepts are recommended by the LCMC and approved by the RC, SCAG staff would develop an outreach program to shop the RC-approved concepts to members of the Southern California legislative delegation. All members of the Southern California legislative delegation should be engaged regarding SCAG's RHNA reform priorities. However, legislators who serve on the Senate Housing or Assembly Housing and Community Development committees, have demonstrated an interest in housing-related issues, or who serve in a leadership capacity would be prioritized for engagement.





If a Legislator is interested in authoring a bill that captures SCAG’s RHNA reform concepts, SCAG could provide draft language, including a recommendation on where to insert the language into the existing code. In addition, Legislators have access to the Office of Legislative Counsel, which assists the Legislature in drafting legislation. Requests by legislators to Legislative Counsel are generally due by the third week of January. The deadline by which a bill proposal must be introduced is generally the third week of February.

Concurrent with legislation being drafted, introduced, and assigned a bill number, SCAG would engage relevant stakeholders, develop model staff reports and support letters, solicit support from SCAG member cities and counties, and encourage support from our region’s COGs and our sister Metropolitan Planning Organizations.

Staff also anticipates prioritizing this topic during the agency’s annual Sacramento Summit, which is tentatively planned for March 2024.
