I am very disappointed and upset that the appeal for the City of Rancho Santa Margarita was denied on Tuesday January 19th 2021. No consideration due to the high risk of fire. I am a resident that has recently lost my fire insurance due to the fire danger. I am now having to purchase fire insurance through the state. Cal Fire has listed this area as High Fire Severity Zone. The area of Rancho Santa Margarita is listed at 67%. Yet the state wants the city to pack in another 680 housing units and 2500 units in surrounding areas of Rancho Santa Margarita. I was there during the evacuation process of both the Silverado and Bond fire. Evacuating large animals. The fire seemed to be far away, but change direction within minutes by the wind. Only giving people a matter of minutes to grab a few personal belongings and family. I can not believe that you would not consider the safety and well-being of the residents. Does the State really need to go through another tragedy like the Paradise fire for the government and Governor to take notice of the Safety concerns of our residents.
