

Statement on July 1 Regional Council Action on the SoCal Greenprint

On July 1, SCAG's Regional Council directed staff to pause the implementation of the SoCal Greenprint for at least 30 days, hold a public hearing, and engage with stakeholders to consider and address concerns.

Consistent with Regional Council direction, a public hearing was held for stakeholder input on Aug. 24 and a second public hearing will be held before the Regional Council as part of the Oct. 7, 2021 Regional Council meeting.

Additionally, based on Regional Council direction, staff is currently:

- 1. Refining the list of data sources and data sets related to engaging in stakeholder outreach and seeking input to address stakeholder concerns.
- 2. Integrating stakeholder feedback into tool technical development and internal beta testing.
- 3. Engaging with stakeholder discussions, meetings, outreach, and messaging with respect to the tool and its proposed data sets.
- 4. Continuing discussions with technical advisory experts for purposes relevant to matters noted above.
