MEETING SUMMARY

1. CALL TO ORDER AND SELF-INTRODUCTIONS

Vanessa Schoenewald, TCWG Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

None.

3. **CONSENT CALENDAR**

3.1. September 24, 2024 TCWG Meeting Minutes The meeting minutes were approved.

4. INFORMATION ITEMS

- 4.1. Review of PM Hot Spot Interagency Review Form
 - Attachment 4.1-1 RIV211201: it was determined that this project is not a project of air quality concern.

Staff from the federal review agencies acknowledged project sponsor's efforts in bringing this project back for interagency consultation and providing a comprehensive overview of the project description at the meeting.

In response to a comment, Rodney Tavitas, Caltrans HQ, clarified that there was no requirement or guidance under the federal Clean Air Act to consider induced demand for project-level transportation conformity purposes. Project sponsor might evaluate potential impacts from induced demand during the environmental review process.

4.2. RTP Update

Agustin Barajas, SCAG, reported the following:

• Connect SoCal 2024 Amendment 1 and the associated transportation conformity analysis were expected to receive final federal approval in December 2024.

4.3. FTIP Update

Agustin Barajas, SCAG, reported the following:

- 2023 FTIP Amendment #23-36 was approved on October 8, 2024.
- 2023 FTIP Amendment #23-37 was undergoing a 10-day public review and comment period and would be submitted for approval in the coming weeks. This would be the final amendment to the 2023 FTIP.
- 2025 FTIP was submitted for final federal approval anticipated in December 2024.
- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-01 was submitted with the 2025 FTIP document to be included in Caltrans' 2025
 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). The 2025 FSTIP, which included SCAG's portions,
 was released for a 21-day public review and comment period that ended on October 31, 2024. The 2025 FTIP
 Amendment #25-01 was expected to receive federal approval after the final federal approval of the 2025 FTIP.
- SCAG staff was preparing 2025 FTIP Administrative Modification #25-02 to capture additional project updates that
 would occur during the period between the federal approval of the 2025 FTIP and the federal approval of the 2025
 FTIP Amendment #25-01.

4.4. EPA Update

Karina O'Connor, EPA, reported the following:

U.S. EPA staff was evaluating the court decision regarding the litigation involving the Mojave Desert Air Quality
Management District (MDAQMD) and would provide updates on the status of offset and highway sanctions and
the proposed Federal Implementation Plan in the MDAQMD's jurisdiction at a future TCWG meeting.

Rodney Tavitas, Caltrans HQ, stated that a project subject to 23 U.S. Code Section 327 that had received TCWG concurrence under a previously conforming RTP/SCS as not a project of air quality concern would need interagency consultation for TCWG to determine if a new TCWG concurrence under a currently conforming SCAG's RTP/SCS would be necessary given the availability of the most recent planning assumptions in force with the currently conforming RTP/SCS (e.g., 2024 RTP/SCS or Connect SoCal 2024).
