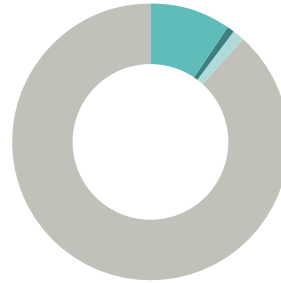


SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION FACTS & FIGURES

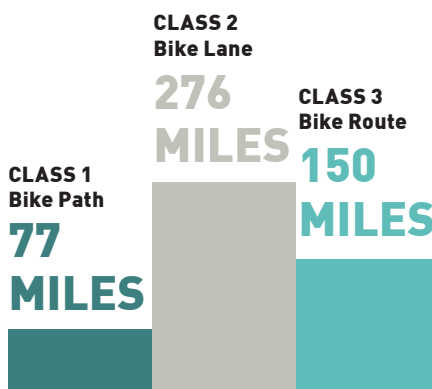

MILES OF BIKEWAY BY CLASS (2012)

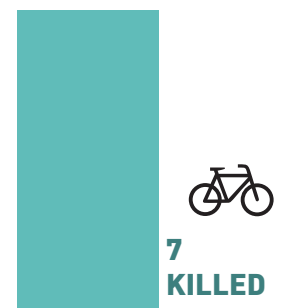

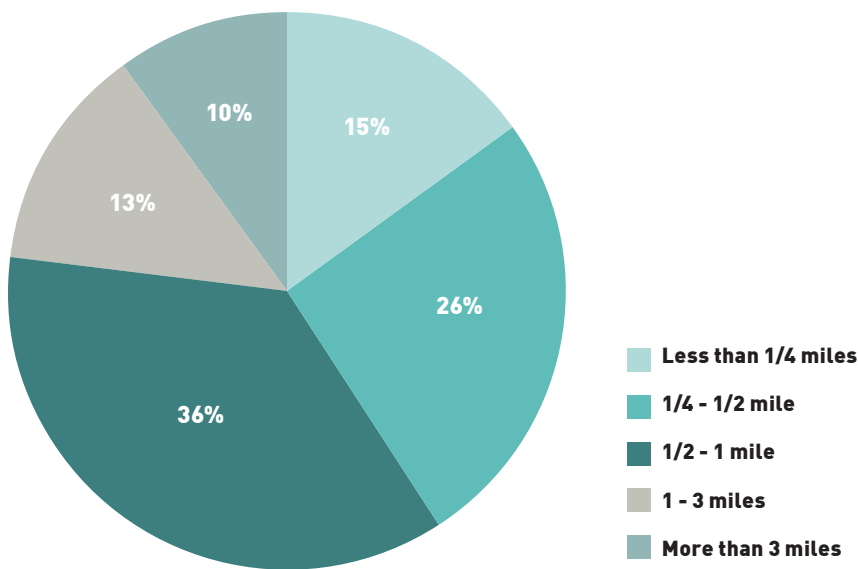

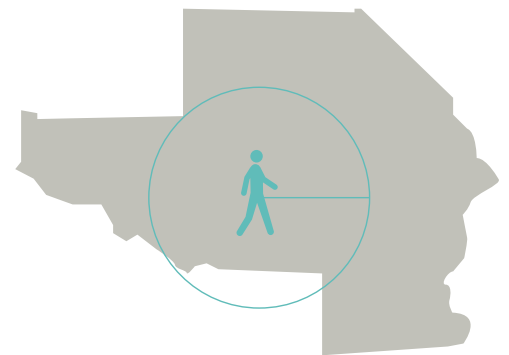
